What's the deal with charter schools?

The PPTA believes that education is a public good and a right for every child. We believe that all students in Aotearoa must be guaranteed a quality education at their local school. Charter schools operate as private businesses, are bulk-funded and operate under commercial contracts. The scheme is designed to privatise the public education system, and puts public education quality and access at risk!



TAKE ACTION!

...AS A BRANCH



Pass the resolution against charter conversion. There are resources to help you run a branch meeting to discuss the topic and to pass a resolution affirming your desire to remain a public school. You should then share this with your principal and school board. This is a good way to front-foot the conversation in your school community and support informed conversations.

...AS AN INDIVIDUAL
